

BURNS TOWNSHIP REGULAR BOARD MEETING, June 7, 2010 at 7:30 p.m.

Supervisor Mitchell called the meeting to order with Pledge to the Flag.

Roll Call: Present, Adams, Cole, Granger, Mitchell and Ritter. Absent: None.

Cole moved, Ritter seconded approval of the agenda as presented. Carried.

Adams moved, Ritter seconded approval of the May 3, 2010 Minutes regular meeting. Carried.

Treasurer Ritter read the financial report.

Chief Musall advised there was one alarm during the month, that of an assist to ambulance to Julmar Dr.-full arrest, involving a 2 car P.I.

Chief would like to get uniforms for firefighters for certain events when a professional look is needed and men are in agreement. He is looking at a shirt, pants, badge, nameplate, belt and shoes. Cost about \$225.00 each, with possible cost total of \$3,600.00. The pants and shirt are washable, good material and they would be kept at the firehall. Granger said that she would be interested in doing the upkeep of the uniforms and they could be stored in a cupboard that we are going to get in the office. Mitchell questioned the need for shoes.

Cole moved, Ritter seconded to buy the above mentioned uniforms, minus the shoes, not to exceed \$3,600.00. Roll Call Vote: Ayes: Cole, Ritter, Granger and Mitchell. Nays: Adams. Carried.

Ritter moved, Adams seconded to pay the bills. Roll Call Vote: Ayes, Adams, Cole, Granger, Mitchell and Ritter. Carried.

Mitchell moved, Ritter seconded to spray brush, 7 miles, at \$235.00 per mile, total cost, \$1,645.00 with 5 miles sprayed on Beard road and 2 miles on New Lothrop road, between Beard road and Lovejoy road.

Roll Call; Ayes, Granger, Ritter, Adams, Cole and Mitchell. Carried.

Mitchell moved, Cole seconded to gravel one mile of Vernon road between Beard road and Bath road at a cost of \$10,825.00. Roll Call; Ritter, Cole, Adams, Granger and Mitchell. Carried.

This puts the road maintenance budget at approximately \$192,649.

Mitchell adjourned the meeting at 8:40 p.m.
