

G. Green called the Byron Council Meeting to order on April 9, 2007 with the pledge to the American and Michigan flags at 7:05 for the purpose of a Special Land Use and Site Plan Application request for Ernest Streeter at 503 & 507 W. Maple Street.

Members Present: Hulett, Morse, Cole, Boillat-Wilcox at 7:35, Musall, Berez, & Hulett.

Visitors: Chief Sampey, Gary Palmer and Darrel Copeman at 7:00, Lonny Latunski from the Shiawassee County Road Commission at 7:15 and Leo Keith and Pat Coleman at 7:35.

Gary Palmer stated that the zoning Special Use Permit for Ernest Streeter at 503 & 507 Maple Ave is a two step process, with this zoning meeting being the 2nd step to expand parking area. Darrel Copeman was concerned at the lighting of the parking area. Hulett made the motion to have Ernest Streeter present a parking lot blue print with the sight being visually reviewed by the council, the proposed lighting would also need to be approved, and he will have to comply with all current zoning ordinances. Seconded by Cole. All Ayes No Nays. Motion Carried.

Meeting was adjourned at 7:20 p.m.

At 7:30 the Regular Council Meeting was called to order.

The minutes were read and approved.

Hulett made the motion to pay the bills totaling \$5,611.75 and the bills paid out through the month totaling \$16,313.62. Seconded by Boillat-Wilcox. Roll Call Vote. All Ayes No Nays. Motion Carried.

The Treasurer's Report was read by Helen Hulett: P. Care-59,967.93, Water-193,712.77, Sewer-714,738.83, L.S.-164,909.67, M.S.-87,007.95, General-171,600.89. TOTAL \$1,391,913.04.

The Police Report was reviewed and Hulett made the motion to accept the verification of hours worked for March of 316.5 hours. Seconded by Musall. All Ayes No Nays. Motion Carried.

Lonny Latunski from the Shiawassee County Road Commission was present to answer any question the council had regarding snow plowing. Morse wanted to know if a study had ever been done on traffic accident on Byron Rd. Mr. Latunski stated he didn't know of one. He stated that Byron Road from Newburg Road to the Village limits is a class A Road. North of Newburg Road to Lansing Road is not a class A Road, and South of Byron on Byron Road is not a class A Road. He stated that one mile of Byron Road from Braden Road to Lovejoy Road the Township is proposing to make that a class A Road at a cost of \$100,000.00/ mile. He stated that years ago they had 90 employees and now they only have 31 employees. He stated Livingston County's funding is more than double of Shiawassee County and we only have 200 miles less of roads than Livingston county, but it goes by population and they have more than double our population. The county is divided in 6 districts with 2 trucks per district. He stated that they do everything in their power to keep the roads cleaned, but we have to work within our budget. The council thanked Mr. Latunski for coming to the meeting.

Between Boillat-Wilcox and Gordon Green eight people had been contacted that are interested in being on the Planning Commission, Jessica Boillat-Wilcox, Sharon Granger, Bryan Mickelson, Robert Skinner, Debra Hunt, Krista Hulett, Tammy Gilbert, and Doug Hetchler. Morse stated to approve the above people with the exception of Krista Hulett because she didn't give a definite answer. Seconded by Cole. Discussion on the motion. Boillat-Wilcox made the motion to amend the motion to include all of the above names. Seconded by Morse. All Ayes No Nays. Motion Carried.

Green reported that Consumers took down 2 of the trees that were unbalanced, but Consumers stated they have never lost a tree by it being unbalanced. There are two other trees that were reviewed by Consumers and they don't seem to be a problem at this time.

The Police Committee met and they would like the officers to receive a \$.50/ hour raise starting April 23rd. Boillat-Wilcox so moved and Hulett seconded the motion. Roll Call Vote. All Ayes No Nays. Motion Carried.

Berecz stated that Doug Fulton will eligible for a 6 month raise as of April 30th. Boillat-Wilcox so moved and Musall seconded the motion. All Ayes No Nays. Motion Carried.

Meeting was adjourned at 8:52.
