C. Green reported that the Cemetery Annexation paper work had been received and is now completed.

Musall wanted to know if the Taser training had been completed. Chief Sampey reported that they have been trying to get the training scheduled with Chesaning hopefully by the 18th or the 22nd.

Ordinance # 2007-1, 92.50 Remedy of Village was read and Boillat-Wilcox made the motion to approve the ordinance with a clarification of plus ten per cent (10%) of the total cost added. Seconded by Morse. All Ayes No Nays. Motion Carried.

Election workers will be Margaret Skinner, Donna Bussell, and Cheryl Green will just fill in for lunches. They will be paid \$10.00 per hour with the chairperson getting an additional \$30.00.
